
SAVE THE ZOO

- After 119 Years, Operating funding was cut in 2012
- FHPZ formed in March 2012
- 2012 We "SAVED the Zoo" paid \$114K of Zoo operating costs



SUPPORT THE ZOO


- Added programming, activities and fundraising initiatives
- Continued to generate awareness and support
- Paid \$228K of Zoo operating costs
- Positioned FHPZ for greater fundraising & sustainability costs



ENHANCE & SUSTAIN

Financial Highlights:

- Generated \$138K of revenue
- Invested in operating (\$1.5K) and capital improvements (\$15K)
- Ended the year with \$288K of total assets



- Development of new marketing materials




